### **OPERATIONS:**

The maintenance crews have been involved in a variety of routine activities including the following:

#### **DISTRICT 1 CREW**

- Crew members responded to snow events by treating the pavement and plowing snow from the roadways.
- The crew completed shoulder repairs on FR 140.
- Ditch improvements were completed on FR 125.
- The Brush Crew responded to requests of service, tree removal and brush cutting at the following locations: FR 136, FR 69, FR 141, FR 131, FR 87, FR 83, FR 89 and Wayland.
- Crews made repairs to roadway surface potholes at various locations across the district.
- Other tasks for the month included: trash/dead animal pick up, mowing the rights-of-way, and street sweeping within subdivisions.

#### **DISTRICT 2 CREW**

- Crew members responded to snow events by treating the pavement and plowing snow from the roadways.
- The crew made repairs to soft spots in the roadway on FR 48 east of Shelby Rd.
- Crew members hand patched potholes in the roadway on Forest Heights St and E FR 156.
- Ditch improvements were completed at the following locations: E FR 52 in Elm Springs, FR 112 and FR 249. The crew removed leaves and debris to improve drainage.

- Crews removed graffiti on FR 48 east of Shelby Rd.
- The crew removed a pickup cab that was left on the side of N FR 147, and also removed a small trailer that was abandoned on N FR 145.
- The Brush crew has responded to service requests for routine trimming and tree removal at the following locations: FR 165 south of E FR 52, N FR 231 at FR 2 and FR 50 west of Rte 125.
- Hand patching was completed at the following locations: FR 231, FR 189 south of Rte 60, FR 193 between FR 132 and FR 136, FR 112 east of FR 203 and FR 48 east of FR 197.
- Other tasks for the month included: trash/dead animal pick up and street sweeping.

#### **COUNTY-WIDE MAINTENANCE CREW**

- **Repaired Soft Spots in Roadway**
  - N FR 93 south of W FR 100: 0.75 mi.
  - Total miles District I = **0.75 mi.**
- **Miscellaneous**
  - Crews responded to winter weather event by treating the pavement and plowing snow from the roadways.
  - Crews cleaned trucks and equipment and conducted Toolbox Talks.

#### **SPECIAL PROJECTS CREW/BOX CULVERTS/BRIDGE MAINTENANCE**

- Replaced driveway drainage pipe on FR 52 west of FR 81 with 30' of 15" CMP
- Replaced driveway drainage pipe on FR 2 west of FR 17 with 36' of 18" CMP
- The crew replaced box culvert #059416202 with 36' of 10's x 5'r box culverts and installed 4 new wing walls.
- Repaired soft spots in the roadway on Berkley and Broadmoor west of Golden to remove and patch with concrete when weather allows.
- Completed box culvert inspections in District 4, all districts now completed.
- Replacing damaged placards on box culverts throughout the county.



## SHOP & WAREHOUSE

- The parts department has acquired and distributed the following parts and materials to the service center and maintenance personnel.

## TRAFFIC CONTROL

- Routine sign maintenance/replacement/installation was performed district wide as well as setting traffic counters and message boards for numerous maintenance projects.
- The crew has nearly completed rebuilding the paint pumps and cleaning the striper in preparation of the next season.
- Repaired and replaced damaged mailboxes from recent snow events.

## ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION

**Farm Road 68 Bridge #0680013, Roadway Improvements & Bridge Replacement (FR 68 over BNSF Railway)** (*Hartman & Company, Inc., Springfield, MO*). The final project documents are awaiting signatures. Burlington Northern RR has been invoiced for their portion of the project.

**Farm Road 146 & FR 129 Roadway Improvements** (*D & E Plumbing & Heating, Inc., Nixa, MO*). The project is complete. The contractor has submitted his argument in writing for

liquidated damages that were presented to him in our November 9, 2022 meeting. Inspection staff is currently reviewing the contractor's claims for additional working days that are identified within the letter.

**Kansas Expressway Extension Project** (*Emery Sapp & Sons, Inc., Springfield, MO*).

Approximately 43% of the project has been paid-out as of January 2023. Backfill around the new Con Span arch structure and adjacent road embankment construction can commence over the arched portion of the structure while the wing wall construction continues. The steel girder bridge substructures have been constructed, and the first 10 of the steel I-beam girder sections have been delivered and placed from end bent 1 to to immediate bent #2. The Weaver Road and Farm Road 145 intersection grading is expected to begin on February 8, 2023. A road closure at this location is expected to last for 6 to 8 weeks to accommodate utility placement, intersection "lowering", and grading and paving.

**Farm Roads 115 & 140 Road Improvements with new Roundabout Project.** (*Hartman & Company, Inc., Springfield, MO*). The contractor is scheduled to begin work in mid-February of 2023, weather permitting.

**Farm Road 44 Box Culvert #044115603 Over Tributary to Little Sac River Replacement Project** (*Hartman & Company, Inc., Springfield, MO*). The contractor has started work on this project, all removal of the old structure is complete. Concrete for all of the new footings has been placed and the contractor is now ready to start forming for the culvert walls.

Right of way inspections for utilities, drive entrances, and all other construction improvements within the right of way, continues to be fairly active. Subdivision construction activities have slowed this month.

## Safety Report Details

### Highway Department Incidents

1. On January 18<sup>th</sup>, Colby Rozell was traveling on his way home after work. He stopped at the intersection of Kearney and Mulroy to turn eastbound heading towards Strafford. As he waited for the light to turn green, he observed a Prime truck heading for the intersection to turn north. The Prime truck proceeded to cut the corner too short and struck the front driver's side of the county vehicle. Contact was made with Prime's insurance company, and the county vehicle is now repaired and is back in service.
2. On January 25, Daniel Lobdell with the westside crew was plowing a cul-de-sac at the end of Westchester St. While attempting to make his turn within the cul-de-sac, the plow truck lost traction and struck a parked car with the front right corner of his blade. The employee contacted his supervisor and the Safety Officer. The owner of the parked vehicle has been contacted and staff is working with them to complete the repairs.

### Highway Department Reportable Injuries:

1. On January 03, Anthony Beal with the westside maintenance crew was helping to organize the back of one of their work trucks. As Anthony was moving an item in the truck he felt pain in his right elbow. Anthony reported the incident to Kelly Williams and continued working with the pain for the next few weeks. After a few weeks of working with the pain he decided he needed to see a doctor. An appointment was scheduled for him with Cox Health. After being seen he was released back to full duty with a brace and two therapy visits. Anthony is still working and improving daily with very little discomfort.

### Sheriff Dept. Incidents:

1. On January 08, Deputy Wallace was headed to assist a motorist who had been involved in a car vs deer motor vehicle accident. While in-route the Deputy struck a raccoon, causing damage to the front passenger's side bumper. The vehicle has been repaired and is back in service.
2. On January 09, Deputy Hicks was catching up to a speeding vehicle on James River Freeway when a coyote crossed the roadway directly in front of him. The coyote was struck with the left front side of the deputy's vehicle. The vehicle was still drivable with the loss of a fog light, a cracked lower bumper and grill. The vehicle has been repaired and is back in service.
