The maintenance crews have been involved in a variety of routine activities including the following:

DISTRICT 1 CREW

- Crew members responded to snow events by treating the pavement and plowing snow from the roadways.
- The crew completed shoulder repairs on FR 140.
- Ditch improvements were completed on FR 125.
- The Brush Crew responded to requests of service, tree removal and brush cutting at the following locations: FR 136, FR 69, FR 141, FR 131, FR 87, FR 83, FR 89 and Wayland.
- Crews made repairs to roadway surface potholes at various locations across the district.
- Other tasks for the month included: trash/dead animal pick up, mowing the rights-of-way, and street sweeping within subdivisions.

DISTRICT 2 CREW

- The crew has nearly completed rebuilding the paint pumps and cleaning the striper in preparation of the next season.
- Repaired and replaced damaged mailboxes from recent snow events.

ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION

Farm Road 68 Bridge #0680013, Roadway Improvements & Bridge Replacement (FR 68 over BNSF Railway) (Hartman & Company, Inc., Springfield, MO). The final project documents are awaiting signatures. Burlington Northern RR has been invoiced for their portion of the project.

Farm Road 146 & FR 129 Roadway Improvements (D & E Plumbing & Heating, Inc., Nixa, MO). The project is complete. The contractor has submitted his argument in writing for

liquidated damages that were presented to him in our November 9, 2022 meeting. Inspection staff is currently reviewing the contractor's claims for additional working days that are identified within the letter.

Kansas Expressway Extension Project (Emery Sapp & Sons, Inc., Springfield, MO). Approximately 43% of the project has been paid-out as of January 2023. Backfill around the new Con Span arch structure and adjacent road embankment construction can commence over the arched portion of the structure while the wing wall construction continues. The steel girder bridge substructures have been constructed, and the first 10 of the steel I-beam girder sections have been delivered and placed from end bent 1 to to immediate bent #2. The Weaver Road and Farm Road 145 intersection grading is expected to begin on February 8, 2023. A road closure at this location is expected to last for 6 to 8 weeks to accommodate utility placement, intersection "lowering", and grading and paving.

Farm Roads 115 & 140 Road Improvements with new Roundabout Project. (Hartman & Company, Inc., Springfield, MO). The contractor is scheduled to begin work in mid-February of 2023, weather permitting.

Farm Road 44 Box Culvert #044115603 Over Tributary to Little Sac River Replacement Project (Hartman & Company, Inc., Springfield, MO). The contractor has started work on this project, all removal of the old structure is complete. Concrete for all of the new footings has been placed and the contractor is now ready to start forming for the culvert walls.

Right of way inspections for utilities, drive entrances, and all other construction improvements within the right of way, continues to be fairly active. Subdivision construction activities have slowed this month.

The Prime truck proceeded to cut the corner too short and struck the front driver's side of the county vehicle. Contact was made with Prime's insurance company, and the county vehicle is now repaired and is back in service.
- 2. On January 25, Daniel Lobdell with the westside crew was plowing a cul-de-sac at the end of Westchester St. While attempting to make his turn within the cul-de-sac, the plow truck lost traction and struck a parked car with the front right corner of his blade. The employee contacted his supervisor and the Safety Officer. The owner of the parked vehicle has been contacted and staff is working with them to complete the repairs.

Highway Department Reportable Injuries:

1. On January 03, Anthony Beal with the westside maintenance crew was helping to organize the back of one of their work trucks. As Anthony was moving an item in the truck he felt pain in his right elbow. Anthony reported the incident to Kelly Williams and continued working with the pain for the next few weeks. After a few weeks of working with the pain he decided he needed to see a doctor. An appointment was scheduled for him with Cox Health. After being seen he was released back to full duty with a brace and two therapy visits. Anthony is still working and improving daily with very little discomfort.

Sheriff Dept. Incidents:

- 1. On January 08, Deputy Wallace was headed to assist a motorist who had been involved in a car vs deer motor vehicle accident. While in-route the Deputy struck a raccoon, causing damage to the front passenger's side bumper. The vehicle has been repaired and is back in service.
- 2. On January 09, Deputy Hicks was catching up to a speeding vehicle on James River Freeway when a coyote crossed the roadway directly in front of him.
