

Notice of Election  
Convention and Entertainment Community  
Improvement District

Notice is hereby given to the qualified voters in the Convention and Entertainment Community Improvement District (the "District") that an election will be held in the City of Springfield, Missouri on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2015 for the following question and imposition of a real estate tax described therein. The District comprises approximately 83.14 acres generally bounded by the BNSF Railway to the north, East Walnut Street and East Saint Louis Street to the south, South National Avenue to the east, and North Benton Avenue to the west. A map depicting the District boundaries is included with this notice.

Qualified voters will consist of the owners of real property per the tax records of the County Clerk as of the 30<sup>th</sup> day prior to the election. The ballot will be mailed to the qualified voters on September 1, 2015. The ballot must be returned by mail or received in the office of the election authority no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Any qualified voter that did not receive a ballot in the mail or lost the ballot received in the mail may pick up a mail-in ballot at the Greene County Clerk's Office located at 940 N Boonville Ave, Springfield, Missouri 65802 between the hours 8:00 a.m. and 4:45 p.m. from and after September 1, 2015.


SHALL THE CONVENTION AND ENTERTAINMENT COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ("DISTRICT") IMPOSE A REAL ESTATE TAX WITHIN THE DISTRICT AT A RATE OF NOT MORE THAN \$3.4000 PER HUNDRED DOLLARS ASSESSED VALUATION FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 50 YEARS OR UNTIL THE REVENUE BONDS ARE PAID, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST, FROM THE DATE ON WHICH SUCH TAX IS FIRST IMPOSED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUE TO PAY A PORTION OF THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON REVENUE BONDS ISSUED TO FINANCE THE COSTS OF CONSTRUCTING A BASEBALL STADIUM AND THE EXPOSITION CENTER IN THE DISTRICT?
