**CITY OF SPRINGFIELD
QUESTION 1**

Shall the City of Springfield make it unlawful for any business entity, that is any person or group of persons performing or engaging in any activity, enterprise, profession or occupation for gain, benefit, advantage or livelihood whether for profit or not-for-profit located or operating in the City of Springfield, to knowingly hire, recruit, dispatch, permit or instruct any person who does not have the legal right or authorization to work (including, but not limited to, being hired full- or part-time for a job, talk, employment, provision of labor or personal services) due to an impediment in any provision of federal, state or local law, including but not limited to, a minor disqualified by non-age, or an unauthorized alien as defined by the United States Code Title 8 subsection 1324a (h) (3). Further, all businesses in the City of Springfield are required to participate in E-Verify to verify the eligibility of all workers and conditional hires to work in the United States. Any business found by the Director of Finance for the City of Springfield to be violating this ordinance may face penalties ranging from suspension of the violator's business permit, suspension of the violator's business license for three (3) business days for the first such violation, a fine up to \$499 and suspension of the violator's business license for 20 business days for the second offense, a fine up to \$499 and a 30-business-day suspension of the violator's business license for the third offense, and a revocation of the violator's business license for the fourth offense?

**CITY OF WILLARD
QUESTION**

Shall the City of Willard, Missouri impose a sales tax at the rate of one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) for the purpose of funding capital improvements to the municipal infrastructure and facilities of the City, including, but not limited to, parks and recreation facilities, by funding the payment of all or a portion of the costs of acquiring, constructing, equipping, financing, operating and maintaining such facilities?

The authorization of said sales tax will authorize the levy and collection of a sales tax in addition to the other taxes provided for by law, on all retail sales made in the City, which are subject to taxation under the provisions of the Sales Tax Law and upon all sales of metered water services, electricity, electrical current and natural, artificial or propane gas, wood, coal or home heating oil for domestic use only, as provided by Section 144.032 of Chapter 144 RSMo. 1986

The authorization of said sales tax will authorize the levy and collection of a sales tax in addition to the other taxes provided for by law, on all retail sales made in such City which are subject to taxation under the provisions of Sections 144.010 to 144.525, inclusive, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, the "Sales Tax Law", as amended.

QUESTION 2

Shall the City of Republic's Water Impact Fee Schedule and Sewer Impact Fee Schedule as adopted on April 5, 2005, and November 7, 1995, respectively, be amended by repealing those schedules and adopting new schedules and establishing a procedure for setting rates as well as an amendment procedure as follows?

Water Impact Fees for residential and non-residential land use will be calculated based on the following meter sizes:

5/8 x 3/4 inch (Typical Residential Size)
1 inch (minimum non-residential size)
1.5 inch
2 inch
3 inch
4 inch
6 inch

Sewer Impact Fees for residential and non-residential land use will be calculated based on the following meter sizes:

5/8 x 3/4 inch (Typical Residential Size)
1 inch (minimum non-residential size)
1.5 inch
2 inch
3 inch
4 inch
6 inch

Council is authorized to establish and/or amend by ordinance the impact fee schedule rates or the method of calculating the impact fees from time to time based upon economic conditions related to the cost of providing for expansion of the sewer and/or water system or in the event of dire emergency. Council may authorize a separate rate structure for meters related to irrigation systems or similar uses.

Water Impact Fees for structures outside the Republic city limits, as they now exist or as may be extended in the future, shall be assessed at one and one-half times the rates established hereunder unless otherwise determined by Council.

No Impact Fees shall be assessed on existing customers or residences currently utilizing the municipal water or sewer system or to residential property that is to be remodeled. All monies will be deposited in the properly designated reserve fund to be used only for system improvements, expansion, related debt service, or dire emergency.

Impact fees will be assessed and all monies collected at the time a building or plumbing permit is issued.
