- Engaging throughout the project to give feedback and ensure the workforce development process is working, the approach improves over time, and the field sees best practices for this kind of regional partnership.

Over the years we've seen and participated in various approaches to solving skilled workforce deficiencies in rural areas. Traditional systems nor more scalable virtual training distributed by national or statewide networks or organizations sufficiently engage regional employers, provide access or the required mix of practical training, coaching, experiential development, and ongoing support required to increase the number and diversity of individuals successfully prepared for the rapidly growing number of these technical positions.

We are confident this partnership will provide access to important new training opportunities and jobs in our region, leading to better economic outcomes.
