Subject: Bailout of ERA Program

Commission,

I received an email from Consumer Credit Counseling Service on Monday. They asked if there was anyway I could expedite the possibility of the program getting a supplement. The commitments they made on behalf of the program are aging and they do not have the cash on hand to pay them. The 2 entities that are balanced out are the ones that are over-extended:

CCCS -76,840.64 CCoSMo -20,994.82 Total -97,835.46

I propose that Greene County extend 97,835.46 of General Revenue funds to these two entities so they can complete the commitments made by the program. This extension should be backed up by an ARPA award of up to 97,835.46 (an allowed use).

Current balances, before final balancing of the other 3 are:

OACAC 18,095.66 CPO 23,164.14 CoC 2,695.63

Total 43,955.43

CPO has balanced out their activity but has one more admin claim to make by middle of June. My goal is to have everyone balance before June 30th. Any funds returned from the remaining 3 would be ERA funds used by CCCS and reduce the ARPA supplement to close out our ERA program. The partners have always been advanced funded and ARPA funds have been paid out as reimbursements. Using general revenue funds until the payments are complete and turning in the completed documentation for ARPA to reimburse the County is the most practical way of completing the commitments.
